

ORDINANCE O-2006-4

~~AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING POSITIONS WITHIN THE POLICE DEPARTMENT AND AMENDING SECTIONS 139.01, 139.02 AND 139.03 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF HASKINS, OHIO AND REPEALING SECTION 139.04 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF HASKINS, OHIO.~~ <sup>Passed 20</sup>

**WHEREAS**, the establishment of positions within the Police Department of the Village of Haskins, County of Wood, State of Ohio, is necessary for the appointment of department members and effective delegation and organization of such members which allows for efficient police service; and

**WHEREAS**, section 737.15 and 737.16 of the Ohio Revised Code allow for the establishment and appointment to such positions.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the Village of Haskins, Wood County, Ohio that:

**Act 1** – That section 139.01 of the Codified Ordinances of Haskins, Ohio be amended so as to read:

**139.01 ESTABLISHED**

There are hereby authorized within the Police Department of the Village of Haskins, County of Wood, State of Ohio, the positions of Marshal; designated Chief of Police, and Deputy Marshals; designated either Police Lieutenant; Police Sergeant; Police Corporal; or Police Patrolman.

**Act 2** – That section 139.02 of the Codified Ordinances of Haskins, Ohio be amended so as to read:

**139.02 CHIEF OF POLICE**

The position of Chief of Police shall have the powers and duties as set forth in Ohio R.C. 737.15, shall be appointed and sworn into office by the Mayor with the consent of Village Council; serve a probationary period as set forth in Ohio R.C. 737.17 and report to and be under the supervision of the Mayor. The position of Chief of Police shall be either a full or part time position for which compensation shall be determined from time to time by Village Council. The Chief of Police shall continue in office until removed therefrom as provided by Ohio R.C. 737.171.

**Act 3** – That section 139.03 of the Codified Ordinances of Haskins, Ohio be amended so as to read:

**139.03 POSITIONS OF DEPARTMENT MEMBERS**

The position of Deputy Marshal shall have the powers and duties set forth in Ohio R.C. 737.16 and upon recommendation of the Chief of Police, shall be appointed and sworn into office by the Mayor. Such positions shall be designated as either Police Lieutenant; Police Sergeant; Police Corporal; or Police Patrolman as recommended by the Chief of Police and approved by the Mayor. All such positions shall report to and serve under supervision of the Chief of Police in accordance with general rules as the Mayor prescribes and shall be either full or part time for which compensation shall be determined from time to time by Village Council. Any employee appointed to such positions shall serve a probationary period as set forth in Ohio R.C. 737.17. The maximum number of positions to which persons may be appointed is to be determined by the Mayor upon recommendation of the Chief of Police.

**Act 4** – That section 139.04 of the Codified Ordinances of Haskins, Ohio be repealed in its entirety.

**Act 5** – It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance where adopted in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements of the Village of Haskins and State of Ohio.
