Ordinance No. 7-2006

Haskins Village Wood County, Ohio

ORDINANCE AMENDING PREVIOUSLY ADOPTED ORDINANCES AND ESTABLISHING WATER AND SEWER RATES

WHEREAS, Article XVIII, Section 3 of the Ohio Constitution provides the authority by which Haskins Village may exercise all powers of local self-government, and

WHEREAS, Article XVIII, Section 4 of the Ohio Constitution authorizes Haskins Village to acquire, construct, own, lease and operate a waste water treatment facility and related structures to serve the municipality and its inhabitants, and

WHEREAS, Haskins Village desires to construct and operate a waste water treatment facility and related structures to serve the municipality and its inhabitants, the costs of which will be paid with the revenue generated from such service, and

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code section 729.49 authorizes Haskins Village to establish and collect rents and charges for the use of sewers, sewage disposal works and other waste water treatment facilities, and

WHEREAS, Haskins Village has established water and sewer rates by Ordinance No. 391-1997, approved December 15, 1997 and amended, in part, by Ordinance No. 1-2006, approved January 23, 2006, and

WHEREAS, the rates to be charges for such services, and the Table of Unit Billing Basis, shall be amended herein

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of Haskins Village, Wood County, Ohio, that:

Section 1. Haskins Village Ordinance No. 391-1997 and Ordinance No. 1-2006 shall be amended as follows:

- a. There shall be a sewer charge consisting of a fixed charge of seventy dollars, (\$70.00), per each Unit Billing Basis equivalent per month.
- b. Said sewer charge shall be applied to residential and nonresidential users.
- c. The Haskins Village Sewer Rates Table of Unit Billing Basis, attached hereto, is hereby adopted and incorporated herein.
- d. The Haskins Village Sewer Rates Senior Residential Discount Policy, attached hereto, is hereby adopted and incorporated herein.

Section 2. All provisions of Ordinance No. 391-1997 and Ordinance 1-2006, (previously cited herein), inconsistent with the provisions established herein are hereby repealed.

Section 3. This Ordinance, and the rates established thereby, shall become effective July 1, 2006.

Section 4. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any other committees that results in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Revised Code of Ohio.




