A RESOLUTION TO ADOPT THE NATIONAL INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SYSTEM

_____, 20____

WHEREAS, response to and recovery from major emergencies and disasters requires integrated professional management and coordination; and

WHEREAS, the President directed the Secretary of the Department of Homeland Security to develop and administer a National Incident Management System (NIMS) to standardize and enhance incident management procedures nationwide; and

WHEREAS, the National Incident Management System provides a structure and process to effectively coordinate responders from multiple disciplines and levels of government and to integrate them with resources from the private sector and non-governmental organizations; and

WHEREAS, use of the National Incident Management System, which has as a key component the Incident Command System (ICS), will improve the Village of Haskins's ability to manage major emergencies and disasters; and

WHEREAS, failure to adopt and use the National Incident Management System may preclude the Village of Haskins from receiving federal preparedness grants or reimbursement for costs expended during major emergency and disaster response and recovery operations;

THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Council of the Village of Haskins, Wood County, Ohio, hereby adopts the National Incident Management System as the foundation for incident command, coordination and support activities. It shall further be the policy of the Village of Haskins to provide appropriate training on the National Incident Management System and its core components to personnel responsible for managing and/or supporting major emergency and disaster operations.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that it is found and determined that all formal action of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of the Council. All deliberation of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio revised code.
