RESOLUTION NO. R-2009-6

A RESOLUTION DECLARING FINES, FEES, WAIVERS, BAILS, BONDS, AND EXCEPTIONS SCHEDULE FOR DEFENDANTS CITED INTO HASKINS VILLAGE MAYOR'S COURT FOR INFRACTIONS OCCURRING AFTER MARCH 2, 2009.

WHEREAS Haskins Village is incorporated by statute of the Ohio Revised Code to promote and enforce an orderly, safe, and law-abiding adherence to the Ohio Revised Code and Haskins Village Code of Ordinances, and

WHEREAS Haskins Village is empowered by the Ohio Revised Code 1905.01 *et seq.* to conduct court and levy fines and customary fees for the enforcement of Ohio Revised Code and Haskins Village Code of Ordinances, and

WHEREAS Haskins Village has established fines, fees, court costs, bails and bonds for infractions of the Ohio Revised Code and the Haskins Village Code of Ordinances, and

WHEREAS Haskins Village maintains a Clerk of Courts Office for the collection of fines, fees, costs, and bonds as waivers in citations nor otherwise demanding a Mayor's Court Appearance, and

WHEREAS *the Haskins Village Council must authorize by resolution all fine, fees, bond, cost, computerization, bail, and bond revenues collected as waivers of non-court-appearance citations.*

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED

Section 1: That Haskins Village does herewith establish and publish its Mayor's Court Bail and Bond Waivers Schedule, attached hereto and marked Exhibit A.

Section 2: That this schedule of collections will be in force from and after the date of passage until further revision,

Section 3: That all ordinances/resolutions hitherto enacted with regard to fines, fees, costs, bails, and bonds in earlier "Waivers Schedules" be and hereby are repealed and without force

Section 4: That the amounts shown in this current Resolution shall be applied to all infractions and citations incurred after the date of this Resolution's adoption by the Haskins Village Council and not retroactive to any previously incurred infractions or citations therein incurred

Section 6: That this resolution is hereby declared an emergency measure necessary for immediate preservation of the health, safety, and welfare of Haskins Village. The reason for this stated emergency is that on September 17th 2008, the Ohio Revised Code mandated increased court costs for certain violations and such change needs to be reflected in the Waiver Schedule used by the Village of Haskins Mayor's Court.

Section 5: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meeting open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
